As you all are well accustomed to the ERP system used in the school, only parents who have cleared the school fees for the session 2024-25 will be able to access the results through the school software on the following dates. The school will remain closed on those days.

## The Fee structure for 2025-2026 session:

- \* From the new academic session 2025-2026, the school will provide monthly fee slips through Edisapp. However, for the convenient of most of the parents we have retained the option for making the payments in six bi-monthly instalments, for those who wish to do so voluntarily, as the instalment payment system remains active in the school software. Hence, while making the payment before the session begins in March, kindly use two fee slips i.e., of April and May. Although fee slips will be issued monthly, parents will use two slips per instalment, making a total of six instalments in a year. Those who wish to pay the entire amount in one go may do so.
- There will be a nominal fee hike as permitted by law. The exact amount payable will be communicated immediately after the declaration of results.
- As agreed by parents, air conditioners (ACs) will be installed in the KG wing for the next session. Additionally, Robotics and AI Labs will be introduced for Classes I to IX from 2025-2026 session.
- The fee booklet for the new academic session will only be issued to parents who specifically request for a hard copy with a payment of Rs.50/. The school prioritizes online payments through the 'Edisapp' portal in alignment with the Government of India's Digital India initiative. We appreciate your cooperation in this endeavour.
- The details of instalment payments are printed on the last page of the school diary for reference.

## Registering your ward to the Promoted Class by Paying the First Installment of Fee:

For the enrolment of the names in our software system of those children who are promoted to the higher classes, the parents are required to pay the 1st installment of the School fees. Otherwise while updating the students' data in the software for the enrollment details; your child's name may be skipped in the students' Attendance Register. To avoid any such embarrassment to your ward kindly make sure that you have done your payment of 1st installment in due time. In case, if the payment is delayed, it will be presumed that your ward has left the school; and moreover, we are not authorized to deal with any student in the school, unless he/she is enrolled in the attendance register.

Parents are requested to collect the Progress report from the School as per the below-given schedule and deposit the school fees, through the school software - online system, on the scheduled dates.

The school will provide the ID Card, Performance Profile, Syllabus, Year planner, School Diary etc. after the reopening of the school. An advance payment for the same would be collected along with the First Installment of School Fee.

New Academic Session begins on:-11-03-2025 (Tuesday) for Classes LKG to X and XII -Timing: 9.00 a.m. to 12.15 p.m. Attendance is compulsory on the first day. In case of illness, the Principal must be informed in writing. The students need not bring the bag on the reopening day. A special prayer service will be held to seek the blessings of the Almighty. Students are allowed to wear the winter uniform till 31st March 2025.
